## CHABAD MALVERN CRECHE 2017 FEES AND PAYMENT

As of **Tuesday 19 January 2017** the following fees will apply for all children.

This fee includes an armed security guard, lunches, snacks, nappies and sunscreen.

<b>Full Day</b>	<p>Mon – Thurs: 7:30am* – 6:00pm          Fridays: 7:30am* – 4:00pm          (Winter Fridays close at 3:45pm. 21/4/2017 – 18/8/2017 inclusive)</p> <p>*Pending council approval to amend our permit to open at 7:30am instead of 8:00am.</p>	\$153
<b>Friday Morning</b>	7:30am* to 12:30 pm	\$100
<b>Full Week</b>	Monday to Friday	\$713

**Please note:** Our policy is full days only from Monday to Thursday and an option for a half or full day session on Friday.

Once your child's days are confirmed and a place is being held for them, creche fees will be charged regardless if the child does or does not attend the creche. One month's notice with full payment must be given to the Creche when terminating your place or decreasing the amount of days you require. For children turning three with a confirmed booking for a full year, a three months' notice with full payment must be given when terminating your place before September 1st.

If you terminate your child from creche prior to September 1st, a one month's notice is still applicable. Notice cannot be given after September 1st, as full fees will apply to then end of the year.
