I make this declaration under the *Marriage Act 1961* (Cth). I believe the statements in this declaration are true in every detail. I am aware that it is an offence under the Act to give a notice to an authorised celebrant knowing that it contains a false statement or an error or is defective. I am also aware that the Act creates offences in relation to bigamy, and in relation to marriage of a person who is not of marriageable age.
